1. Outline of 2Q Financial Results for FY2024

UCHIDA Company-wide: First-half Business Results

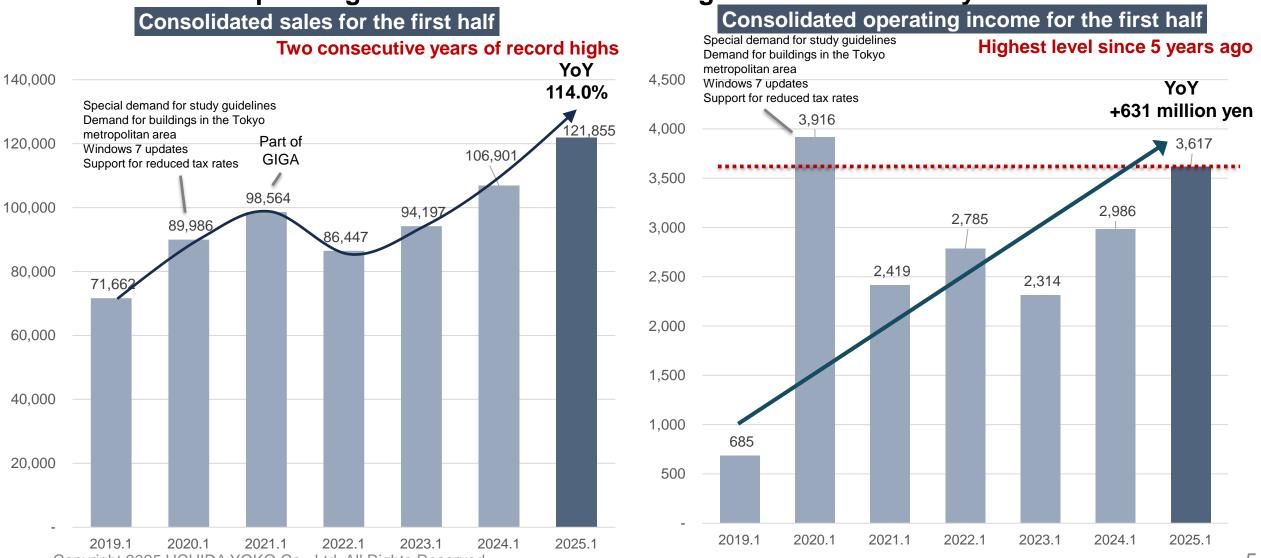
In the first half of the year, we saw a significant increase in both income and profits.

Company-wide: Trends in First Half Business Results (Sales/Operating Income)

Sales for the first half of the year were the highest ever for two consecutive years, while operating income was the second highest in the last five years.



UCHIDA Points Concerning 2Q Financial Results for FY2024

Although there were significant fluctuations in quarterly results compared to the previous year, they were in line with initial expectations. The strong performance in the second quarter meant that the cumulative total for the first half of the year was slightly higher than initial expectations.

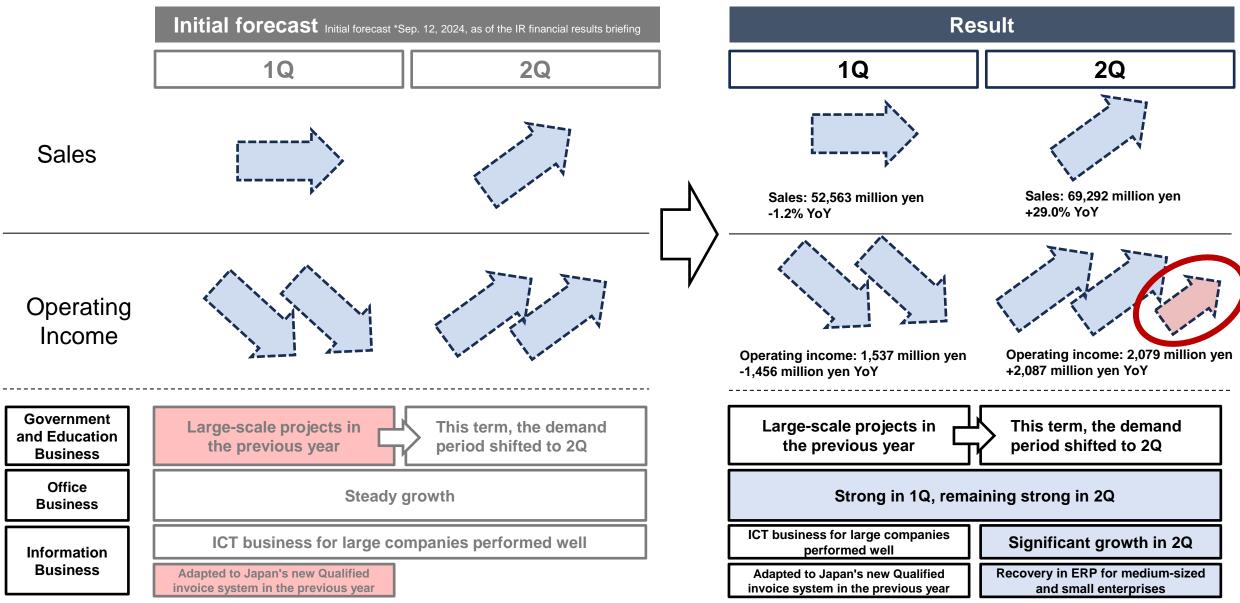
Quarterly fluctuations were as expected at the beginning of the term (down in the first quarter, up in the second quarter)

- The peak in the first half of the year for the educational ICT business shifted from the first quarter to the second quarter.
- It was a reaction to the concentration of projects to adapt to Japan's new Qualified invoice system in the first quarter of the previous year.

Factors behind strong performance in the second quarter

- The number of office renovation projects increased in the second quarter of this fiscal year.
- Medium-sized and small enterprises' SI projects, which had been on hold due to them having to adapt to the new invoice system, returned, and there was an increase in the second quarter.

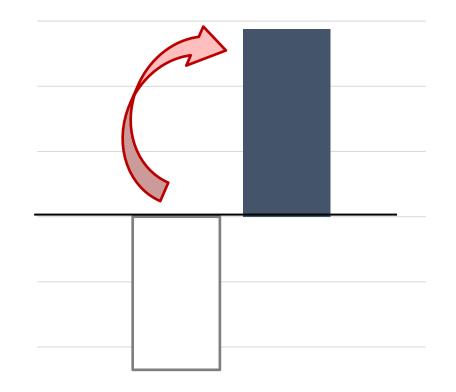


UCHIDA Profit Difference from the Previous Year: 1Q/2Q Change

Quarterly fluctuations were as expected at the beginning of the term (down in the first quarter, up in the second quarter).

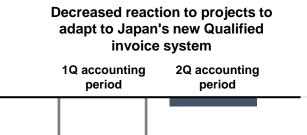

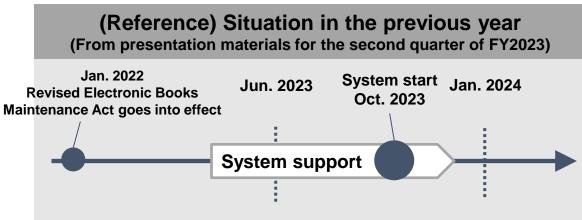

Reaction to the concentration of projects to adapt to Japan's new Qualified invoice system in the first quarter of the previous year.

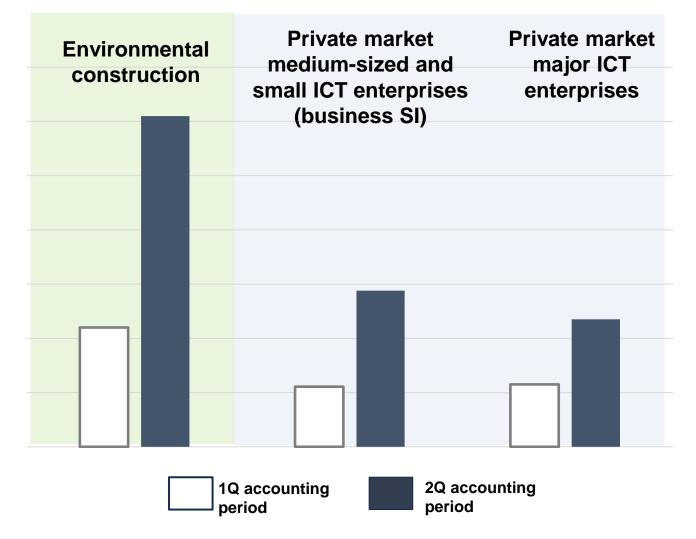

- Demand for educational ICT projects shifted to the second quarter compared to the previous year. Therefore, while there was a significant decrease in performance in the first quarter, it recovered as expected in the second quarter.
- We responded to the growing demand for learning systems to deal with the large number of terminals being prepared, as well as projects to integrate school administration networks into a secure environment using a full cloud system, etc.

• There was also an increase in projects related to public facilities, such as municipalities, and library systems.

Regarding the future of municipal standardization and GIGA terminal updates

- Projects to standardize municipal government systems will begin in earnest in FY2025, but the first phase will begin in the third quarter of FY2024, which is the end of the customer's fiscal year.
- Although the updating of GIGA School will begin in earnest in FY2025, some of the updates will begin in the third quarter of FY2024.

- With strong corporate performance centered on major companies and an increase in investment appetite to secure human resources, there has been a notable recovery in office investment, which had temporarily contracted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- In addition to improving the working environment in R&D departments, there was also an increase in new demand for hybrid work styles.
- Office renovation projects expanded from the head office to each department, including the establishment of bases nationwide.
- Especially this year, there was a large increase in the second quarter.

• As a result of our past efforts, we have increased our track record of creating working environments in city halls by making use of our expertise in school facilities in the Government and Education Business.

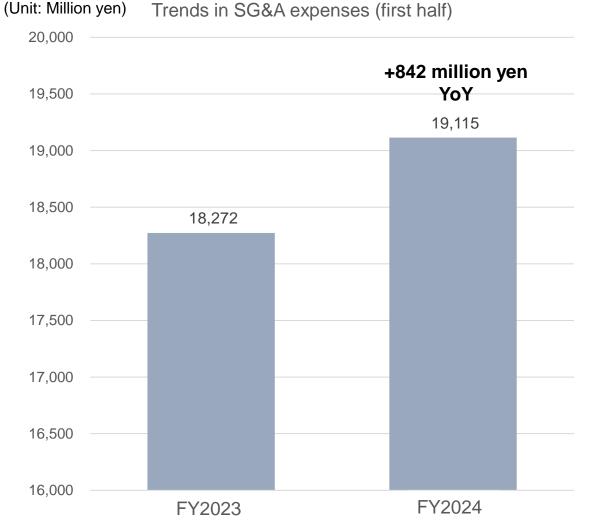

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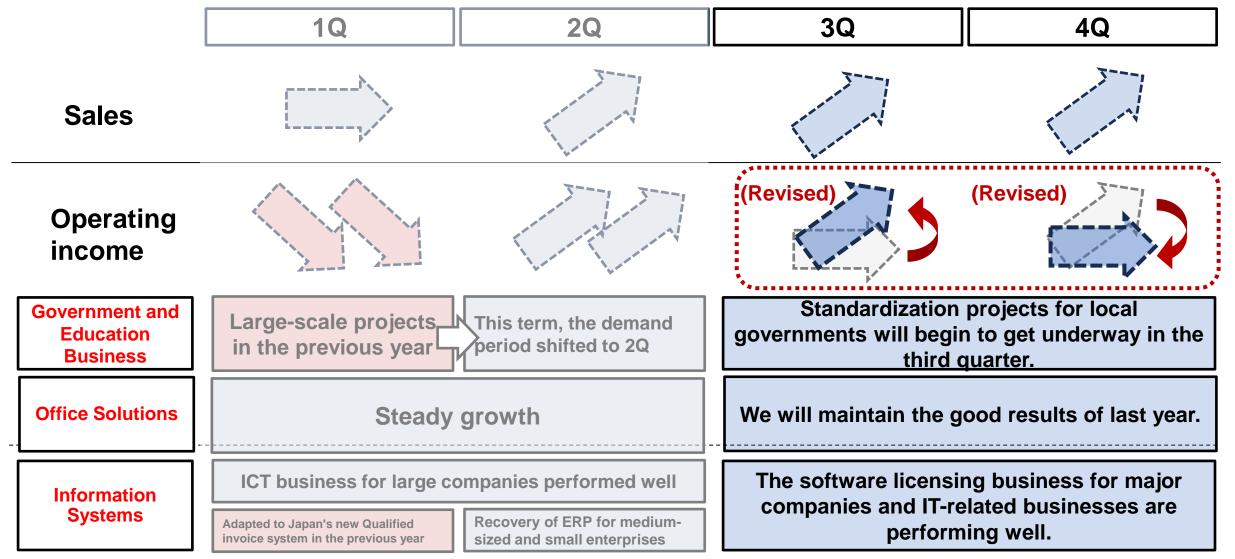

The third quarter will exceed the previous year. The fourth quarter will also be strong.



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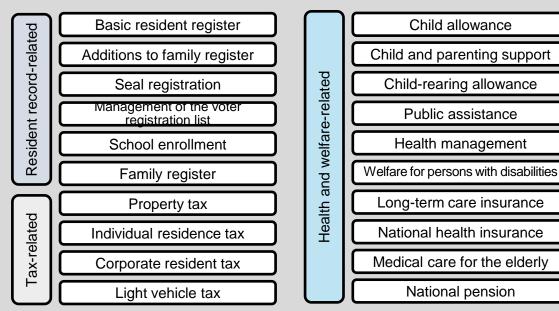

Enactment of the Act on the Standardization of Information Systems for Local Public Entities (May 2021)

Mandatory use of a system that complies with the standards

We aim to migrate to a system that complies with the standards by 2025.

20 operations targeted for system standardization



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The system that has been introduced will be modified in line with the national guidelines for standardizing municipal government systems for each type of administrative work.

The company that introduced it will be primarily responsible for making any necessary modifications.

Since August 2022, the system standardization specifications have been revised many times by the government according to the type of work.

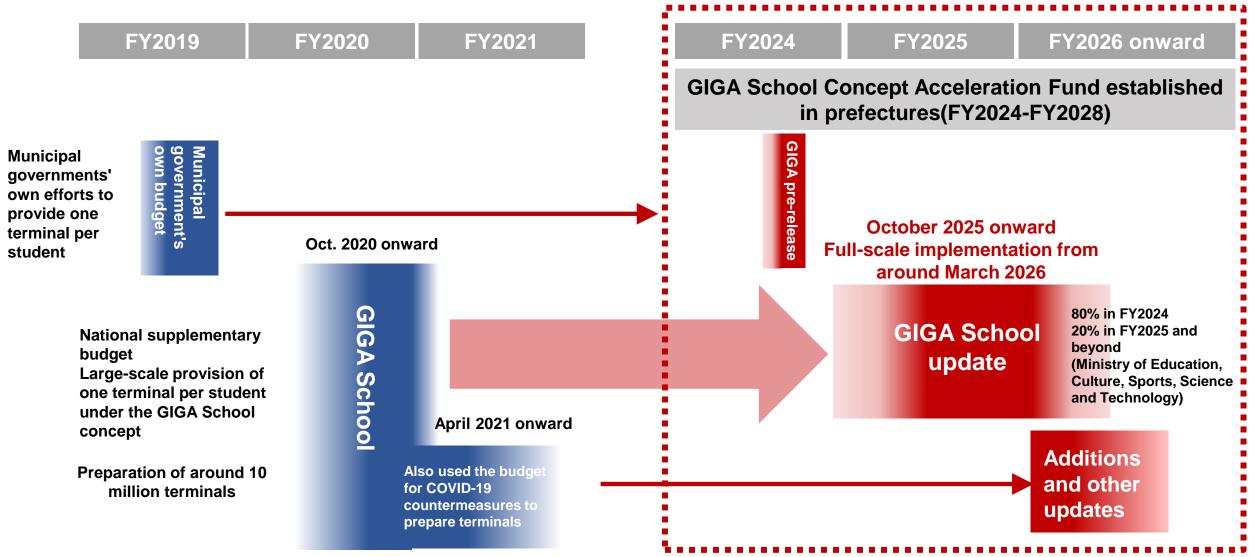
Now that the standard specifications for each task have been largely finalized, system standardization will begin to progress in stages. Generally, this will be completed by March 2026.

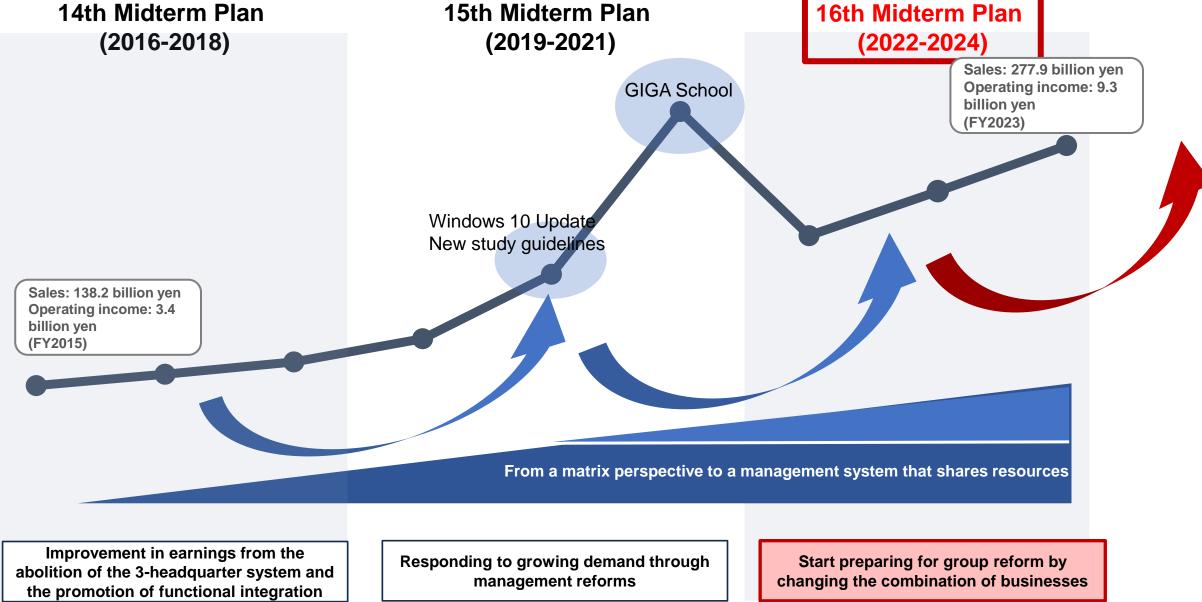
UCHIDA Reference: GIGA School Terminal Update Schedule

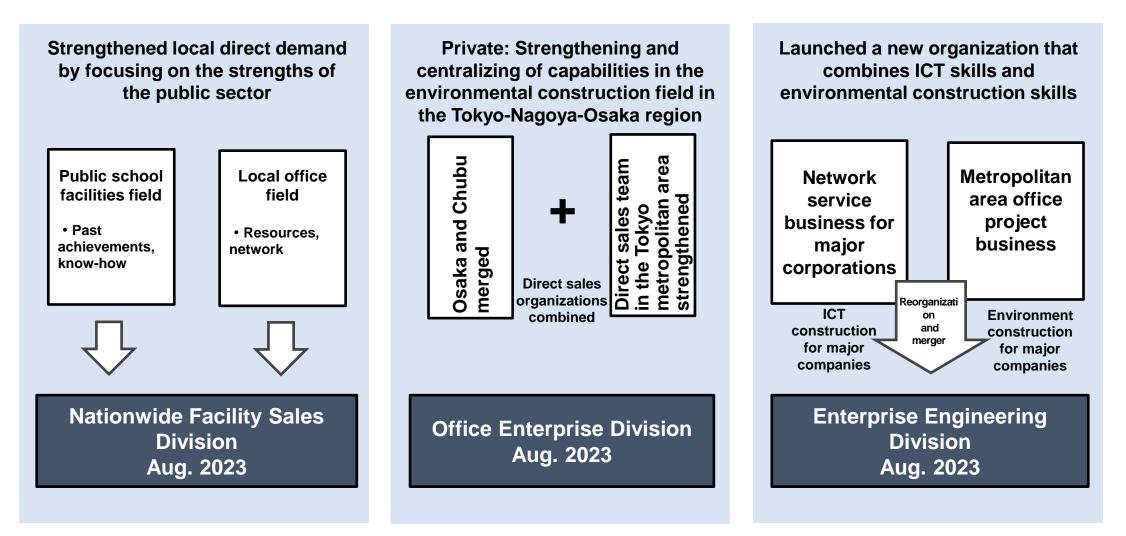


Integration of ICT Related R&D Departments and Development Functions for Each Business Segment (From August 2022)

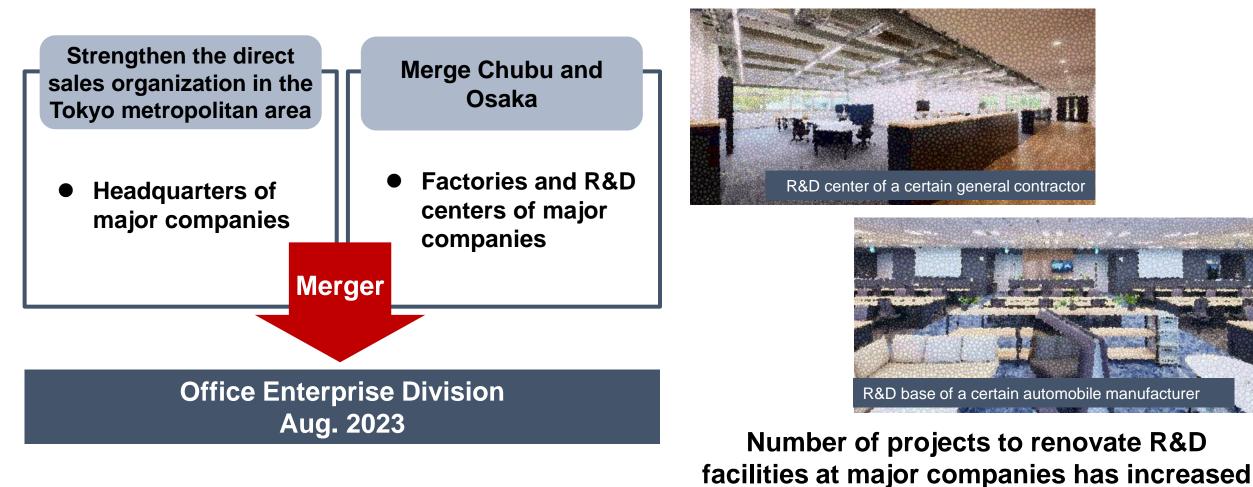

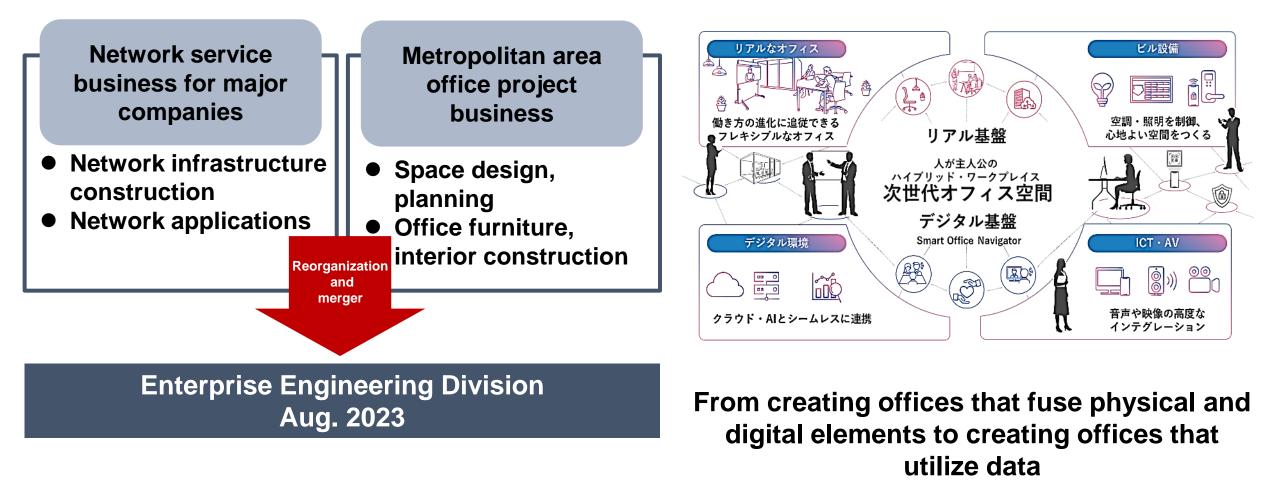

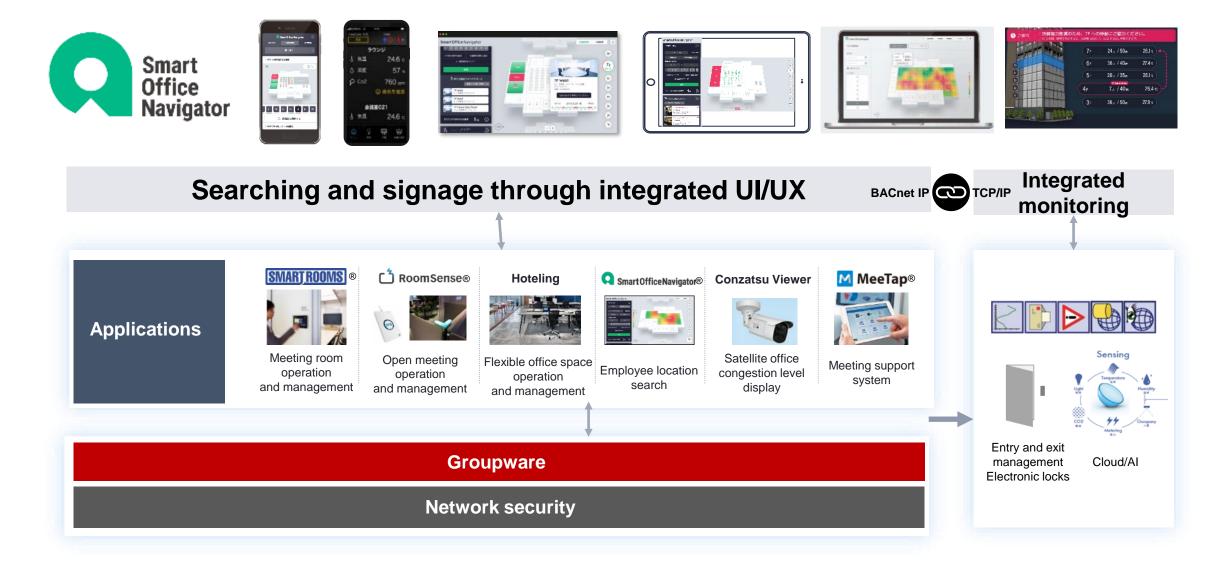
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Example: Collaboration Between Information Business and Office Business



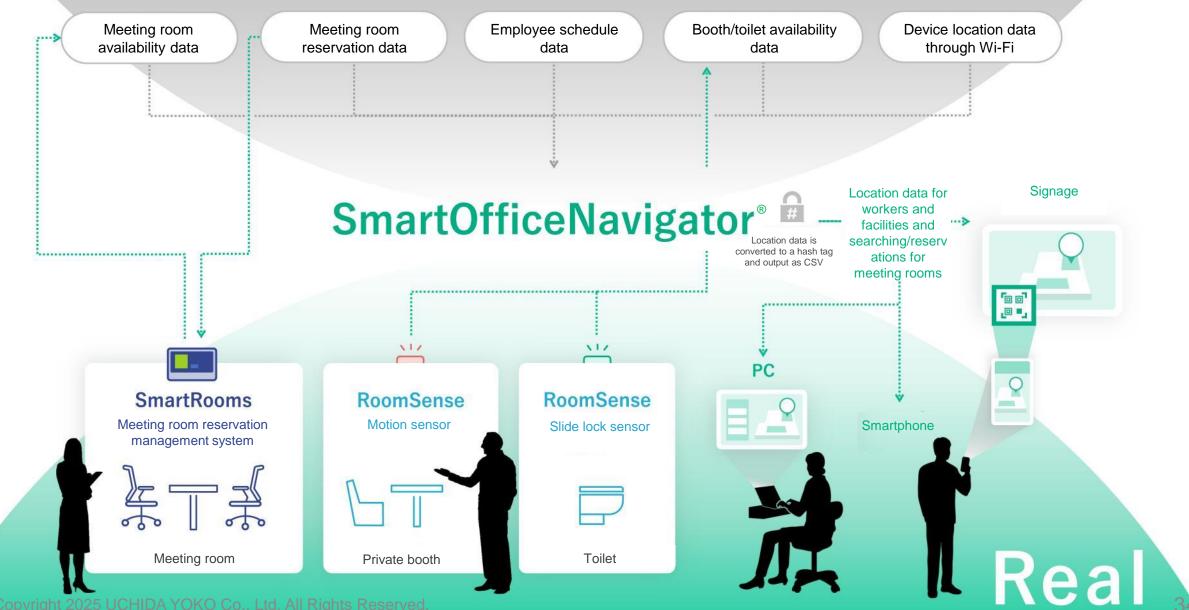
